Scholarship Eligibility:

- A graduating senior from a WCSD #6 high school or surrounding area high school
- Pursuing a 4-year degree at an accredited college/university or a 2-year college with the intent to complete at a 4-year institution
- Accepted into a collegiate athletic program
- Completed application, supplemental additions, and essay

Scholarship Details

- Two \$5,000 scholarships will be awarded for a 4-year program
- One \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded for a 2-year program
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college/university

Application Process:

1. Complete the scholarship application.
2. Write essay (500 words) using this prompt: Michael was a man of integrity and it showed in his everyday life. Who in your life shows integrity and how has that inspired you to have the same impact on someone else?
3. Submit a copy of your transcript.
4. Submit two letters of recommendation, preferably from a teacher, coach, employer, etc.
5. Application, essay, and submissions are due by March 31, 2024 to either the address below or on-line at michaelraylee.com.
6. Scholarship recipients and their parents will be honored guests at the 4th Annual 'Mike Lee Memorial Golf Tournament' banquet held at the Aims Welcome Center on June 3, 2024.
